## HOW DO WE GET THERE?

### Transportation

Your job is to get to the San Diego Airport. Your transportation from the San Diego Airport to RDSN and back are included in the price of your JCME registration.

Busses leave the Airport Thursday at 10am and will get you back to the Airport Sunday by 5pm. When crossing the border we unload and carry all luggage across and with us through the Visa process, remember you will be responsible to carry all of your personal belongings.

## WHAT WILL WE EAT?

### Dining

Be sure to bring something for lunch before you load the bus on Monday at 10am. After that all meals are served in our dining hall and our kids may join your team for some lunches and dinners. All items served in our kitchen and café are safe for consumption. If you or someone on your team has food allergies please be sure to talk with them about how to prepare for their stay, as no accommodations will be available in our kitchen.

## WHERE WILL WE SLEEP?

### Housing

We have several group dormitories assigned by gender, each equipped with bunk beds and foam pads. There are also 4 men's showers, 4 women's showers, as well as outhouses (maybe actual bathrooms by the time you arrive). We simply ask that you join us in using water conservatively and do your very best to keep our campus and facilities clean and damage free.

### Communication

WiFi is available for purchase at Café La Misión and most carriers include international plans. Using mobile phones in Mexico without making arrangements in advance can result in excessive roaming charges. Many of our group members choose to place their mobile phones on airplane mode to avoid all charges or at the very least will opt to turn off cellular data upon crossing the border.
