HOW DO WE GET THERE?

Transportation

Your job is to get to the Cluj Airport in Romania. Your transportation from the Cluj Airport to Misiunea and back are included in the price of your JCME registration, you will only need to cover your lunch stop on the way in and out.

Buses leave the Airport Thursday at 11am and will get you back to the Airport Sunday by 3pm. If you need to arrive or depart to and from Cluj a day earlier or later in order to make the scheduled transportation arrangements, please let us know as we may be able to add an alternate pick-up location that may be closer to the city center in Cluj. Also, remember when packing that you'll be responsible for carrying your luggage up a couple flights of stairs upon arriving to the ministry sight and that it will all need to fit under the bus, so pack light.

WHAT WILL WE EAT?

Dining

Be sure to bring some cash for lunch on the way in and on the way out but once you arrive to Misiunea all of your meals will be provided. All items served in our kitchen and nearby are great

cafes and restaurants if you desire to venture out in the city, everything provided will be safe for consumption. If you or someone on your team has food allergies please be sure to talk with them about how to prepare for their stay, as no accommodations will be available in our kitchen.

WHERE WILL WE SLEEP?

Housing

We have two full floors of our building that will be assigned by gender, your job is to bring a tent, sleeping bag and foam pad or air mattress (don't want to bring one? add one to your ticket upon purchase). On each of those assigned floors are restrooms and showers also assigned by gender. We simply ask that you join us in using water conservatively and do your very best to keep our building and facilities clean and damage free.

Our building is called Misiunea (formerly Tarnava) Building and is located at Str. Mihai Eminescu Nr. 69, Sighisoara, Mures, 545400, Romania.

Communication
